Having in mind that the new Serbian Law on Personal Data Protection has been adopted in the last quarter of 2018, and it was in power as of January 2019, this seminar was an excellent opportunity to raise awareness about this important topic as well as to provide more information about what the new Law brings.

CANSEE and Ministerial Delegation visit world's largest mining convention PDAC in Toronto, Canada

CANSEE President Mr. Aleksandar Obrenović and Managing Director Mirjana Dončić-Beaton, together with the Ministerial Delegation comprised of the Minister of Mining and Energy Mr. Aleksandar Antić, State Secretary Stevica Dedjanski and Assistant Minister Mr. Ivan Janković, the Ambassador of Canada to Serbia, Macedonia and Montenegro, H. E. Kati Csaba and Trade Commissioner at the Embassy together with CANSEE members of Exploration and Mining Industry Group, visited PDAC (Prospectors and Developers Association of Canada), the largest international fair and convention in the field of mining, that took place in Toronto from March 3-6, 2019.

PDAC is the leading voice in the world for the mineral exploration and development community. With approximately 8,000 members around the world in all sectors of the mining industry, PDAC's mission is to promote a globally-re-

sponsible, vibrant and sustainable minerals industry. As the trusted representative of the sector, PDAC encourages best practices in technical, operational, environmental, safety and social performance. PDAC is known world-





wide for its annual PDAC Convention, which is regarded as the premier international event for the mineral industry. In 2018, the convention attracted more than 25,000 people from 135 countries annually.

On Sunday, March 3, for a third consecutive year, Euromax Resources and Mundoro Capital were hosting the "Western Tethyan Belt" session at PDAC. The session highlighted the Tethys as an emerging and increasingly attractive region for mineral projects as demonstrated by takeovers of former participants of this Tethyan Session. This year



participating companies were CANSEE member companies Euromax Resources, Mundoro Capital, Dundee Precious Metals, MedGold Resources, as well as individual companies Zijin Mining, Velocity Minerals, Euro Sun Mining, Eldorado Gold, Georgian Mining and Chesterfield Resources that discussed their projects, while insights into the region were provided by government representatives.

A technical keynote presentation by Tim Baker, Chief Geoscientist at Eldorado Gold Corporation, kicked off the morning session and provided a review of the Cretaceous and Cenozoic deposit types and resources across SE Europe and Turkey, was followed by a Government Spotlight by the Serbian Minister of Mining and Energy, H.E. Minister Antić. The western portion of the Tethyan Belt remains underexplored yet is rich with mineral potential, low cost exploration services, local skilled workforces and good infrastructure. During his visit to PDAC, Minister Antić will also attend the IMMS – International Mines Ministers Summit where each year, Ministers responsible for mining and energy meet to discuss how to support a responsible and competitive industry that contributes to the sustainable development of local communities and the country as a whole.

Visitors had the opportunity to find out more about the process of brewing, the production of beer by steeping a starch source in water and fermenting the resulting sweet liquid with yeast.

John Molson founded Canada's oldest beer brewery on the banks of the St. Lawrence River in Montreal. He wrote,

"My beer has been universally well-liked beyond my most sanguine expectations." In 1959, Molson Canadian was first brewed and today is one of Canada's most iconic and best-selling brands. Adolph Coors, a penniless brewer's apprentice, stumbled on the perfect water in Clear Creek at the foot of the Rocky Mountains. 105 years later, Coors Light was born and would go on to be enjoyed by beer drinkers in over 25 countries worldwide. Frederick J. Miller began his apprenticeships in brewing in adolescence and by 1849 was brewmaster to a prince in Sigmaringen, Hohenzollern. After immigrating to the US in 1854, he settled in Milwaukee then leased and later purchased the suburban Plank Road Brewery for \$2,300. He brought a unique brewer's yeast from Germany – its descendant yeast is still used in some of Molson Coors beers.

552-CARAT YELLOW DIAMOND FOUND AT CANADA'S DIAVIK DIAMOND MINE NORTHEAST OF YELLOWKNIFE

A diamond pegged to be the largest known gem-quality stone found in North America was discovered at a Northwest Territories mine in October 2018, according to Dominion Diamond Mines.

The 552-carat yellow diamond was found at Diavik Diamond Mine, according to a company news release.

The news release from Dominion Diamonds makes note of how unexpected it is to find an intact gem of this size in the Northwest Territories. Jim Pounds, the executive vice-president of diamonds for Dominion Diamonds, elaborated the reason for this. "Canadian diamonds are some of the oldest in the world," he said. "They almost go back to the beginning of the formation of Earth itself and individually, Canadian diamonds are over three-billion years old, many of them."
